Child Abuse in America

To provide the audience with increased awareness of the individual, familial, community, societal, and political realities of child abuse in America, and to inspire them to do their part to combat the epidemic.

- *Format:* Informative, Experiential, & Persuasive Lecture with Q&A (Length 1.25-3 Hours)
- *Topics:* Recognizing the Reality; Parenting for Prevention; Making a Difference

Trauma, Dissociation, & Recovery

To provide the audience with a survivor's perspective on what is required of a therapist working with survivors and multiples.

- *Format:* Informative & Experiential Lecture with Q&A (Length 1.5-3 Hours)
- *Topics:* A Survivor's Multigenerational Story; Therapist Tools; Expanded DID Basics; Client Tools; Stages of Healing; Therapist Self-Care

Understanding Multiple Personality (DID Q&A)

To provide the audience with an opportunity to explore the mind and life of an actual multiple in order to promote greater understanding of multiplicity (etiology and realities) from a first person plural perspective.

- *Format:* Informative & Experiential Q&A with Brief Intro (Length 1-3 Hours)
- *Topics:* Implicating Ritualistic Sexual Abuse; Demystifying Multiplicity; Living, Functioning, and Parenting; Therapeutic Goals for Multiples

Bodywork: A Survivor's Perspective

To provide the audience with awareness (or increased awareness) of the crucial importance of bodywork to survivors' healing processes, as well as some significant issues pertinent to doing bodywork on survivors.

- *Format:* Informative & Experiential Q&A w/Brief Intro (Length 1-2 Hours)
- *Topics:* Survivors' Need for Bodywork; Potential Issues with Bodywork; Survivors' Needs in Bodywork
